1. Background

Integrated Service for Displaced Population (ISDP) is a humanitarian and development organization established in 2010 in Puntland State of Somalia. ISDP works to support displaced and vulnerable communities through health, protection, livelihood, and resilience-based programming. With 65% of staff being women, ISDP prioritizes gender equity, community participation, and accountability.

Vision

A society with improved living conditions and equal opportunities for all poverty, injustice and all forms of violence against women girls are eliminated.

Mission

Committed to improving living conditions and advancing gender equality in partnership with communities to build sustainable, healthy, and productive communities in Somalia, free from violence and discrimination against women and girls.

As part of malaria prevention efforts, ISDP will implement a mass distribution of Long-Lasting Insecticide-Treated Nets (LLINs) in Bossaso District. The campaign will use DHIS2 Tracker for digital household-level data collection and Last Mile Supply Management (LMSM) for LLINs stock management. To ensure effective implementation, ISDP seeks qualified Campaign Supervisors to lead distribution teams and ensure data quality and accountability.

2. Role Purpose

The LLINs Campaign Supervisor will oversee distribution teams, ensure proper use of digital tools (DHIS2 and LMSM), monitor stock movements, ensure adherence to distribution protocols, and compile daily and final reports. The supervisor will also ensure that field teams follow ISDP's safeguarding, communication, and beneficiary accountability guidelines.



3. Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Lead and supervise teams of Community Distributors and Social Mobilizers during household-level LLINs distribution.
- Ensure correct use of DHIS2 Tracker for household registration and reporting.
- Monitor LLINs stock levels and support accurate tracking using LMSM.
- Conduct daily briefing and debriefing meetings with distribution teams.
- Verify data accuracy and ensure daily submission of complete digital reports.
- Troubleshoot field challenges and support distributors in completing coverage.
- Ensure proper messaging on correct LLINs usage is delivered to households.
- Compile daily progress summaries and contribute to the final campaign report.
- Ensure compliance with ISDP Code of Conduct, PSEA, and safeguarding policies.

4. Minimum Qualifications and Experience

Education (Minimum)	Diploma in Public Health, Nursing, Midwifery, Community Development, Social Science, or related field.
Preferred Education	Bachelor's Degree in Public Health, Nursing, Monitoring & Evaluation, Social Work, or related field (Advantage).
Experience	Minimum 1–2 years experience in health campaigns, field supervision, or humanitarian project coordination.
Technical Skills	Experience in digital data collection systems (preferably DHIS2). Experience in LLINs or immunization campaigns is highly desirable.
Soft Skills	Strong leadership, communication, conflict-resolution, and team coordination skills.
Language	Fluency in Somali; working English proficiency is an advantage.

- Strong commitment to beneficiary dignity and accountability.
- Ability to work respectfully with IDP and host communities.
- Candidates with previous experience in LLIN campaigns within Bosaso district, community health volunteers, and health facility volunteers will be **strongly considered**.

 - PSEA (Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) Policy
 - Data confidentiality and reporting standards.
